MEETING THE PHOTOGRAPHER BEHIND THE SCENES

I began my photography career shooting concerts. I just decided one day that I wanted to photograph Rob Zombie. Some finaggling later, I found myself standing feet away from the man not knowing what the hell I was doing and loving every minute of the experience. I was hooked on, of course, virtually the most difficult type of photography - low light, fast action, get it in three songs without flash and you are out! I still love it and still shoot shows and interview rockstars. It does not suck to be me.

But, once I became comfortable with the rigors of concert shooting, I became a bit bored. Shame on me, but I actually thought at one point, "If I shoot another guy with a guitar, I'm going to scream." It is still an amazing



thrill and challenge, but I have extended myself creatively. I've included in my repertory, conceptual horror. However, I do sometimes feel bogged down in the darkness and have begun also looking to beauty and fashion. With this particular shoot, I did not go completely into the light because, while it may not be obvious, the backdrop for this shoot was a cemetery. However, while most cemetery shoots convey horror or melancholy, my style team and I and model, Katelyn Phillis were inspired by the beauty and not the darkness. Of course cemetery grounds are beautiful. The grounds are replete with peaceful landscapes, colorful floral gardens and spectacular architecture. The history of any cemetery is often a bewitching attraction as well, as it can be both comical and sad. Clearly, the histories are captivating and the design elements are often beautiful. But, the real beauty lies in the visitors. Often mournful, yes. But, the people who visit are examples of, in the purest sense of the word, love. The people who visit are without agendas, without expectation of reward and without hope of the return of their affections. They are solely there out of love. The people visiting the cemetery are examples that unconditional love can exist and that true love transcends time. So, our inspirations were beauty, grace and love. And, for a little fun and graceful flavor, I asked Katelyn to channel her inner Dita Von Teese with a touch of Morticia Addams.
